## Bethesda Mission Overnight Winter Shelter Rules and Policies WINTER 2016

The Winter Overnight Outreach at Susquehanna Harbor Safe Haven (SHSH) is the primary overnight site for the season in Harrisburg, and Bethesda Mission serves as an overflow. Transportation will be provided by the Mission to SHSH each evening and each morning from SHSH to the Salvation Army.

Bethesda Mission welcomes you as our overnight shelter guest. Our overnight winter shelter will operate from December 1, 2016 – March 31, 2017. The mission of the overnight shelter is to provide a clean, safe environment where a man can get some sleep away from the elements during the winter months. **Please note the following:** 

1. Doors will open at 9:30pm and will close at 10pm. Guests coming after 10pm must register as a 10-day guest or they will not be accommodated.

- 2. Once overnight winter shelter guests are signed in, they will be taken to the chapel where they will receive a mat and linens. Guests should be ready to sleep by 10:30pm.
- 3. Lights will be out at 10:30pm and wake up will be at 6:00am.
- 4. Guests are expected to leave the building by 6:30am, no exceptions. Linens must be put back in the cart and mattresses neatly put away.
- 5. Breakfast is available each morning at the Salvation Army on Green Street. Bethesda Mission will not provide breakfast.
- 6. Guests who found to be disrespectful to staff, the building, or other guests of the Mission may be asked to leave and may be banned from the Mission. Final decisions on such matters rest with the Program Director of Bethesda Mission.
