Susquehanna Harbor Safe Haven – 8 p.m. – 7 a.m. (for Men) **1805 N. 12th Street, Hbg.**

Guests are entered into Safe Haven between 8 - 10 pm. Guests must be out by 7 am. Coffee, tea, small snack available to single men. Coffee available next morning. No meals, no showers. Capacity: 25. Some volunteers still needed on various days. Please call Susquehanna Harbor Safe Haven at 717/232-5029 for details.

Downtown Daily Bread – 7:30 p.m. – 6:15 a.m. **Emergency Night Shelter for Men** **234 South Street, Harrisburg**

The Night Shelter at Downtown Daily Bread will operate each evening from December 1, 2018 – March 31, 2019. Doors will open at 7:30 p.m. and close at 8:30 p.m. Lights out at 10:00 p.m.

No meals and no showers. If possible, potential clients should visit Downtown Daily Bread between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. Monday through Friday to complete an intake form prior to visiting the Night Shelter.

Clients are expected to leave the shelter by 6:15 a.m., and may return for regular Downtown Daily Bread services and the Day Shelter, which operates from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. 7 days a week. Capacity at night is 40 beds for men.

If needed, Downtown Daily Bread will contact Susquehanna Harbor Safe Haven or Bethesda Mission for overflow. Contact Susan Cann at 717-238-4717, ext. 123.

YWCA of Greater Harrisburg – 8:00 p.m. – 7 a.m.

The YWCA offers an overnight shelter for women who are living on the street during the cold weather months beginning December 1 unless there is a winter weather emergency; and ending March 31. The doors open at 8:00 pm and close at 9:30 pm. Light refreshments are available. Exit is at 7 am the following morning. Capacity is 9 women. Volunteers are needed. Bethesda Mission - 8:00 p.m. – 6:30 a.m.
(for Men)
611 Reily Street, Harrisburg

Male guests will be accepted when the wind-chill falls below 20 degrees, or when there is significant snowfall/freezing rain/sleet. Once daytime wind-chill temps rise above 20 degrees, guests will be asked to leave.

Overnight guests must sign in and then will be taken to the chapel to receive linens and a mat. Guests should be ready to sleep by 10:30pm.

1. Doors open at 8 pm and will close at 9 pm. Guests coming in after 9 pm must register as a 20- day guest or they will not be accommodated.
2. Once overnight winter shelter guests are signed in and our roll call and devotions are completed the guest will be taken to the chapel where they will receive a mat and linens. Guests should be ready to sleep by 10:30 pm, which is lights out.
3. Guests are required to leave the building by 6:30 am, after putting their linens in laundry cart and putting away their mats.
4. Breakfast is available at the Salvation Army on Green St.; Bethesda Mission will not provide breakfast.
5. Guests who are found to be disrespectful to staff, other guests, the building, will be asked to leave and may be banned from the Mission.
