

Resolution 5-2015

CAPITAL AREA COALITION ON HOMELESSNESS

Whereas, the Capital Area Coalition on Homelessness (CACH) is the lead entity for the “Continuum of Care” (CoC) PA501 as defined and determined by the US Department of Housing and Urban Development to coordinate homeless housing and service in the County of Dauphin and the City of Harrisburg.

Whereas, 24 CFR §578.7(a)(5) Interim Rule of the HEARTH Act requires CoCs to develop, adopt, and maintain a CoC Governance Charter, hereto referred as Governance Charter.

Whereas, the primary aim of this Governance Charter is to define how CACH fulfils 24 CFR 578 Subpart B, on establishing and operating a CoC, as well as fulfilling HUD HMIS requirements.

Whereas, a sub-committee appointed by the Coordinating Committee will annually review the Governing Charter of CACH including attachments, and propose any recommendations, amendments, editions or deletions as necessary to reflect the on-going purpose and progress of CACH.

Now, therefore be it Resolved, that the Coordinating Committee of the Capital Area Coalition on Homelessness hereby approve and adopt the following Capital Area Coalition on Homelessness CACH Governance Charter as attached, including the mechanism for an annual review that may result in future amendments, editions, and deletions as stated.
